Dryden Rd Parking Garage: In 2015, the Public Art Commission started the transformation of this multi-level parking garage in Collegetown into a vibrant free outdoor gallery. There are murals by artists including Mary Beth Ihnken, Kellie Cox, Steav Kim, Marc Reed, Kurt Piller, Melody Often, Andy Dolan, Baháí Junior Youth Group, Dennis & Maria Bauser, Ishan Eldridge and Dan Burgevin. Many blank walls remain for future murals!
